 - Your motivations for this research stay and the expected achievements
 - Specify if your research work is part of a previous collaboration between the two research institutions? If so, which one?
 - Specify the main objectives of your research mobility
 - How are you planning to continue your collaboration after the research mobility?
- → Invitation letter (Invitation_name): Invitation letter from your French research institute in French or English with the dates of the stay and the logo of the host university or research institute.

Incomplete applications received after the deadline will be considered ineligible.
